

conto River Kids is a group of outdoor enthusiasts who assist kids with life threatening illnesses attain their outdoor dreams by providing unique hunting and fishing adventures.



Oconto River Kids began in 2012 with a landowner who envisioned a local volunteer group providing hunting and fishing opportunities for children with life threatening illnesses and their families. He contacted the local DNR Conservation Officer, who shared a passion for mentoring young hunters. They immediately recognized the possibilities and identified other key individuals who shared their vision and passion. That group of individuals dedicated themselves to the idea and moved forward to create Oconto River Kids. The group continues to grow, but maintains its simple grass roots approach to providing unique hunting and fishing experiences for children with life threatening illnesses and their families. In 2014 Oconto River Kids reached a milestone when it was incorporated as a non-for-profit corporation in the State of Wisconsin and now operates as a Wisconsin charitable organization.



Our signature event is the Oconto River Kids Bear Hunt held every September. 6-10 children and their families are selected to participate. A significant amount of preparation and planning goes into this event. We also host deer hunting and annual fishing trips.

Life threatening illnesses are usually a significant financial burden for families. Oconto River Kids covers all expenses associated with hosting these families and running the events. This includes lodging, meals, taxidermy, meat processing, and all ancillary expenses. We receive a great deal off support from our local businesses for which we are very grateful.
