He contacted the local DNR officer who was like-minded and they dedicated themselves to this idea. They immediately identified other key individuals who shared their vision. Our signature event is the annual Oconto River Kids Bear Hunt. We will be hosting nine critically ill children and their families in September of this year. A great deal of planning and prep work goes into this event. Everything from the Black Bear tags, hunting land, bait, mentors, dog teams, hunting assistants, taxidermy, butchering, housing and meals is either volunteered or donated. Without our wonderful volunteers and supporters, Oconto River Kids would never have become a reality.





The 2014 hunt will be dedicated in memory of Jacob Van Schyndel who successfully hunted with our group last year. Jacob lost his valiant fight against cancer early this year. Our thoughts and prayers are extended to his family and friends. We had a great hunting experience with Jacob and his father.

Our group is completely funded through the generous donations of time, money and gifts from people who believe in our mission. If you are interested in our organization there are a number of venues for your support.

- * *Taxidermy*: Last year five of our six kids harvested animals. We provide a bear rug or shoulder mount for each successful hunter.
